

Nephtys caecoides - Inner ramal cirri begin on setiger 4, no ribbed pigment pattern on dorsum Nephtys californiensis - no subdistal unpaired papilla, middorsal distal papilla present (see N. californiensis voucher sheet), no ribbed pigment pattern on dorsum.

Comments:

We get all three species (*N. ferruginea*, *N. caecoides* and *N. californiensis*). Unpigmented specimens with interramal cirri starting on setiger 3 should be examined for Methyl Green stain and proboscidial papillae arrangement.
