


Eusyllis blomstrandi Cmplx

In the past this has been identified as *E. blomstrandi* because of the black band on the pharynx. However live coloration and other characters are different. L.Harris Sept 2020



- The ventral cirri of the first setiger is not foliaceous.
- All the dorsal cirri are a little longer that half the width of the body.
- The blades of the compound setae serrated; relatively short.
- The body has faded brown pigment spots on the dorsum in two rows, a pair on each segment.
- The proventriculus runs from setiger 7 -12.
- I cannot see if there are teeth on the pharynx.
