



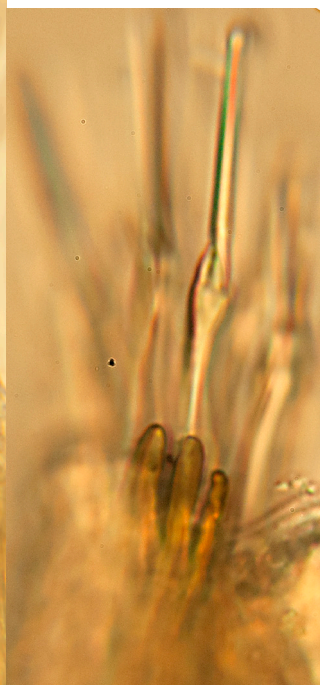
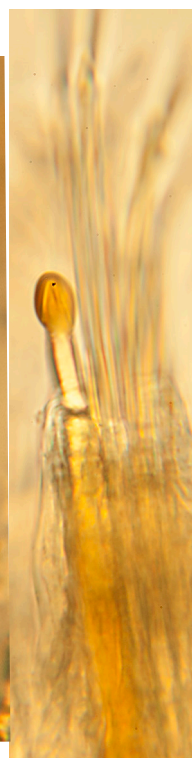
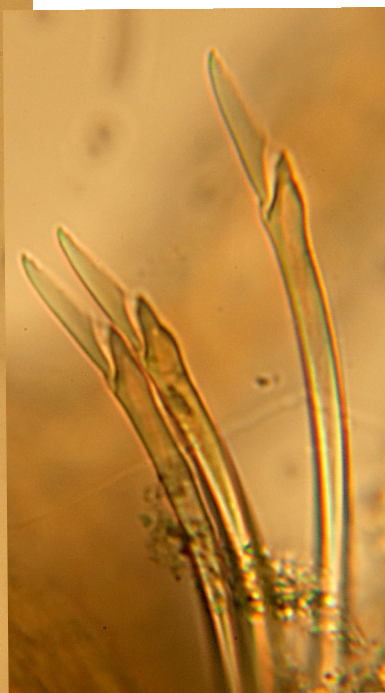
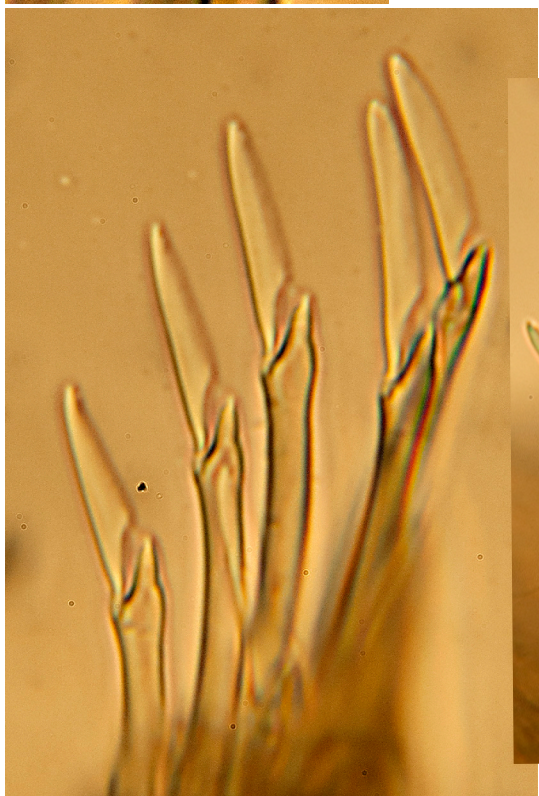
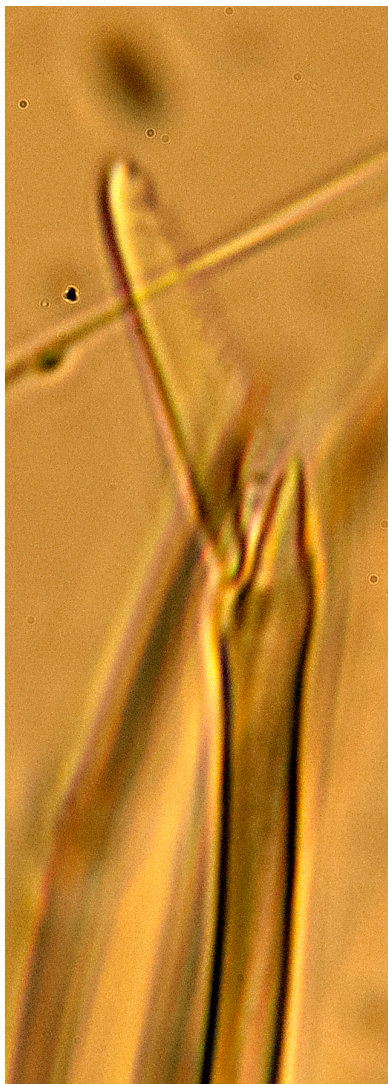
- Between 55 and 70 setigers (~15 mm)
- Antennae with about 8 articles
- All dorsal cirri short; 6-7 articles in anterior setiger; 2-3 indistinct articles in posterior
- All compound setae with short finely-serrated blades; either uni-dentate or sub-bidentate throughout body (difficult to resolve in scope)
- Acicular spines: 1-3 per setiger, some with single rounded (match stick like) ends; most blunt spines
- Pharynx to setiger 11
- Proventriculus setigers 12-18
- Pygidium with about 4-6 indistinct articles (wrinkled?)
