*Aphelochaeta glandaria*, Blake, 1996

1. No methyl green staining pattern
2. Only very slightest serration to abdominal neurosetae. (Appear nearly smooth at 400X magnification.)
3. Golden hue to anterior ventrum often visible.
4. Posterior setigers only slightly inflated, with a slight dorsal and distinct ventral groove.

This is a common Pt. Loma species

(Careful of confusion with *Monticellina tessellata*)
