






Nicippe tumida

1959)


1. Mouthparts forming a cone-like bundle; urosomites 1 and 2 each with postero-dorsal tooth, urosomite 2 tooth much longer than that on urosomite 1..... *Rhynohalicella halona*
- Mouthparts not forming a cone-like bundle; urosomite 1 with bifurcate tooth or without teeth..... 2
2. Urosomite 1 with bifurcate dorsal tooth..... 3
- Urosomite 1 smooth, lacking dorsal teeth..... 4
3. Gnathopods 1 and 2 with carpus subequal to or shorter than propodus, dactyls not shortened; urosomite 2 without tooth *Nicippe tumida*
- Gnathopods 1 and 2 with carpus much longer than slender propodus, dactyls short; urosomite 2 with single tooth..... *Pardalisca tenuipes*
4. Rostrum large, reaching 2/3 of antenna 1, article 1; gnathopods 1 and 2 with propodus not broad proximally, narrow, elongate, and generally longer than carpus; coxae 1–2 rounded *Halicoides synopiae*
- Rostrum short; gnathopods 1 and 2 subequal to carpus, propodus broad proximally, narrowed distally; coxae 1–4 subquadrate broader than long *Pardalisella symmetrica*




Urosomites 1-3 & telson,

synopiae (from JL Barnard 1962)




Gnathopods 1

JL Barnard 1959)




Rhynohalicella halona (From J.

Halicoides synopiae (From JL Barnard 1962)


- Antenna 1 with multi-articulate accessory flagellum
- Rostrum large (reaching 2/3 peduncular article 1)
- Gnathopods 1 & 2, article 6 narrow, elongate
- Gnathopods 1 & 2, article 5 w/o lobe, article 5 < 6
- Urosomites smooth, without dorsal teeth



Nicippe tumida (from J L Barnard 1959)

- Antenna 1 with multi-articulate accessory flagellum
- Rostrum small/absent
- Gnathopods 1 & 2, article 5 with lobe (deeper than long)
- Gnathopods 1 & 2 article 6 normal, not narrow or elongate, article 6 > 5
- Urosomite 1 with bifurcate dorsal tooth; urosomite 2 without tooth






Pardaliscella symmetrica

(From JL Barnard 1959)


- Antenna 1 with multi-articulate accessory flagellum
 - Rostrum small
 - Gnathopods 1 & 2, article 5 without lobe (longer than deep)
 - Gnathopods 1 & 2 article 6 distally narrowed, not elongated, articles 5 & 6 subequal
 - Urosomites 1–3 smooth, without teeth



Pardalisca tenuipes

(From Sars 1895)

- Antenna 1 with multi-articulate accessory flagellum
 - Rostrum small/absent
 - Gnathopods 1 & 2, article 6 elongate, narrow, article 6 < 5
 - Gnathopods 1 & 2, article 5 without lobe
 - Urosomite 1 with bifurcate dorsal tooth, urosomite 2 with single tooth



Rhynohalicella halona

(From JL Barnard 1971)

- Antenna 1 without accessory flagellum
 - Rostrum small
 - Mouthparts as projecting conical bundle
 - Gnathopod 1, article 5 short, narrow, without lobe, Art 6 >> 5
 - Gnathopod 2, article 6 elongate, narrow; article 6 > 5
 - Urosomites 1 & 2 with single tooth, urosomite 2 tooth longest
