## Caprella gracilior

## **Diagnostic Characters:**

- Head and body usually smooth anteriorly and with two pairs of dorsal tubercles on pereonite V.
- This animal is very slender, with pereonites I and II much elongated.
- G1 with strongly serrate grasping margin to propodus and dactylus
- G2 three times longer than it is broad, extreme distal portion setose; palm with proximo-medial grasping spine and sccessory spine, distal pison spine separated by a cleft from a moe distal triangular projection.
- Gills slim and oval.




FIGURE 20 — Caprella gracilior. Subadult male, lateral view. Male appendages. Female gnathopod 2.
