Photis lacia

Diagnostic Characters:

Male:

Antennae one and two subequal, weakly setose

G2, palmar tooth square and defining tooth not extending below the level of the dactyl hinge, dactyl, inner margin slightly sinuous, notched distally

G1, normally subchelate

G2 enlarged, palm excavate

P6, not grossly enlarged

Coxae 1-5, lower margins weakly setose

Female:

G1, segment 5 as long as segment 6

G1 and G2, segment 6 triangular in shape, palm demarcated by a change of angle

G2, segment 2 not anterodistally lobed

G1, segment 5, posterior lobe half or more than the length of the anterior margin

G2 palm oblique

Coxae 1-5, lower margins weakly setose




Figure 26. Photis lacia J.L. Barnard © 3.0 mm, Q 3.3 mm, Trevor Channel, Barkley Sound, Vancouver Is., B.C.
