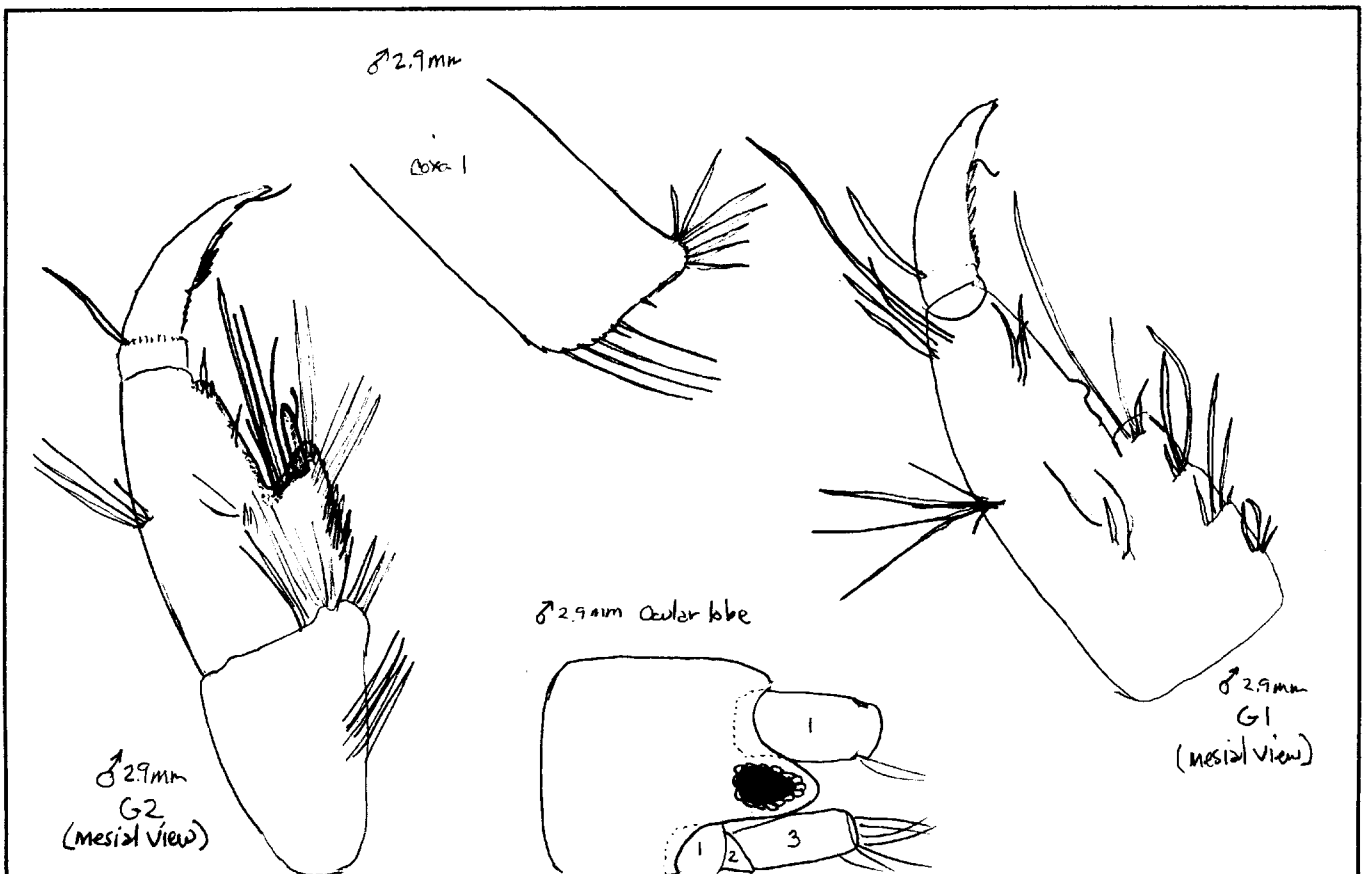
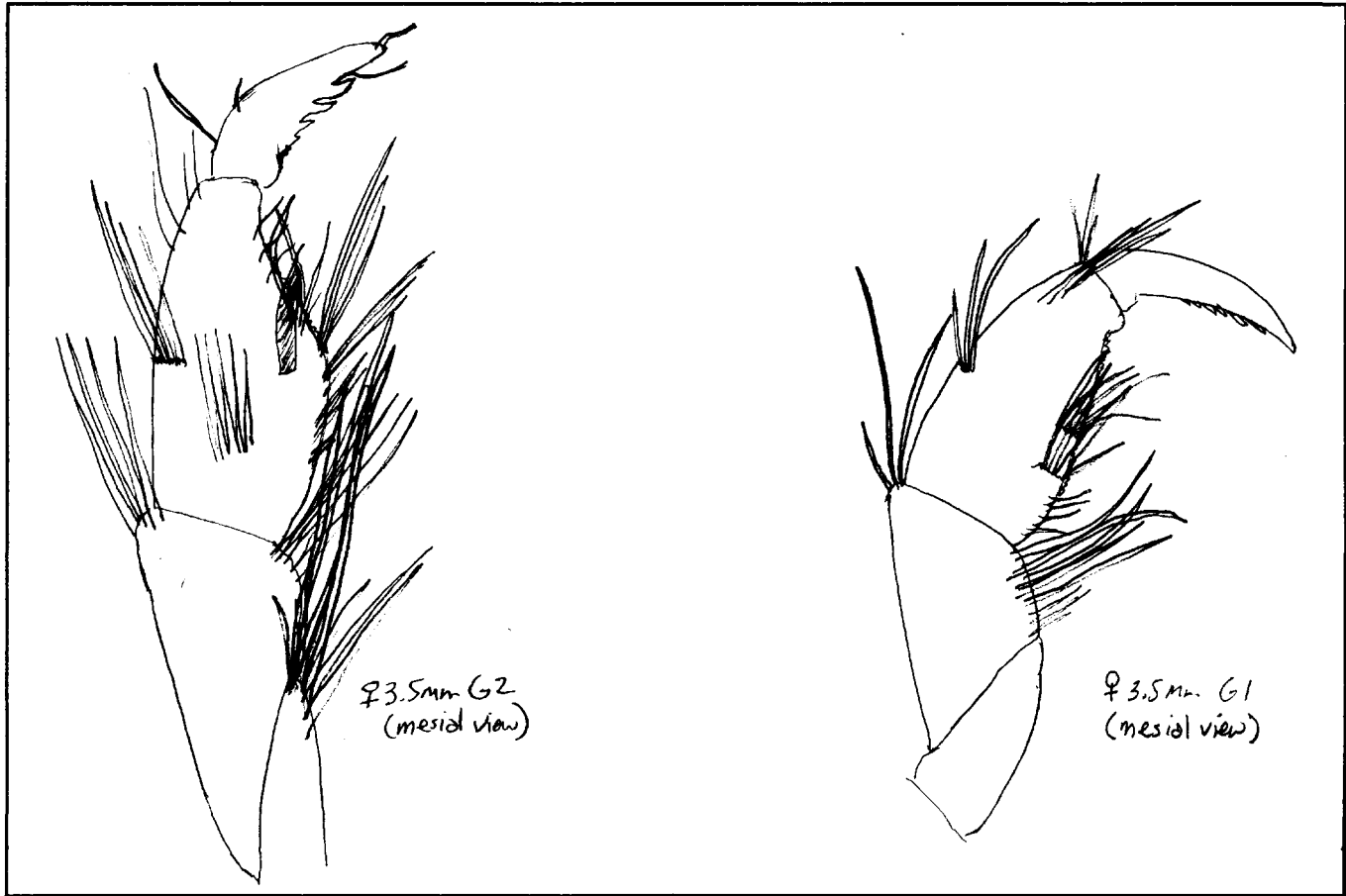

Distinguishing Characteristics: Ant 1 ant 1 short, only 2x ocular lobe; ant 3 = 1.5x ant 1; ant 2 = 2x ant 1 (both in ♂ & ♀)
Coxa 1 (both sexes) - subquadrate with anterodistal knob bearing radiating setal group
Coxae 1-5 subequal in length; in adult? male 2 & 3 actually longer than 4 & 5 (not so in ♀)
all coxae with < 10 ventral setae - ♂ (2.9mm) ^{R 7, 7, 6, 4, 4} 5, 6, 5, 4, 3, ♀ (3.5mm) ^{R 8, 9, 9, 7, 2} 6, 9, 9, 7, 6
Eye lobe relatively blunt, concave on both sides; Ant 3 of A2 not geniculate, ≈ 120% of eye lobe length, about 70% of Ant 5 length, ≈ 50% of Ant 4 length; Ant 3 of larger diameter than Ants 4 & 5. Both A1 & A2 sparsely setose, setae not in graded series, longest ≈ 2.5x article diameter, most 2x or less
♂ G1 ant 6 slightly longer than Ant 5, palm stepped, no defining tooth; anterior lobe < 50% of length of Ant 5
G2 ant 6 50% longer than Ant 5, palm excavated and oblique, with large defining tooth on mesial face
