Peramhithoe humeralis

Diagnostic Characters:

- Body large 19-35 mm
- A2 slender, proximal segment not fused
- G1 segment 5 longer than segment 6
- G2 subequal to G1, both palms transverse, segment 5 longer than deep and subequal to 6
- G1 and G2 dactyls, in males, subequal
- P5 segment 4 longer than segment 5
- P7 larger and longer than P6




Figure 11. Peramphithoe humeralis (Stimpson) & 15.0 mm; Q 19.0 mm, Trevor Channel, Barkely Sound, Vancouver Is., B.C. 25 May 1977
