
Dulichiella appendiculata

Diagnostic Characters:

Peraeon generally smooth Abdomen often mid-dorsally toothed or mucronate, rarely spinose or setose or laterally toothed Head, anterior lobe rounded, inferior antennal sinus reduced, often notch-like Eye generally small, rounded, pigmented Antenna 2 shorter than antenna 1 G1 and G2 in males, markedly unequal, G2 propod and dactyl large, carpus short E3 produced

Gnathopod 2, male, propod and dactyl grossly enlarged Uropod 3, outer ramus slender, sublinear, rod-like Pleon segments 1-3, usually postero-dorsally toothed Urosome segments 1 and 2 with dorsal teeth
