- Telson emarginated (looks slightly bifid)
- Rostrum small or absent
- No eyes

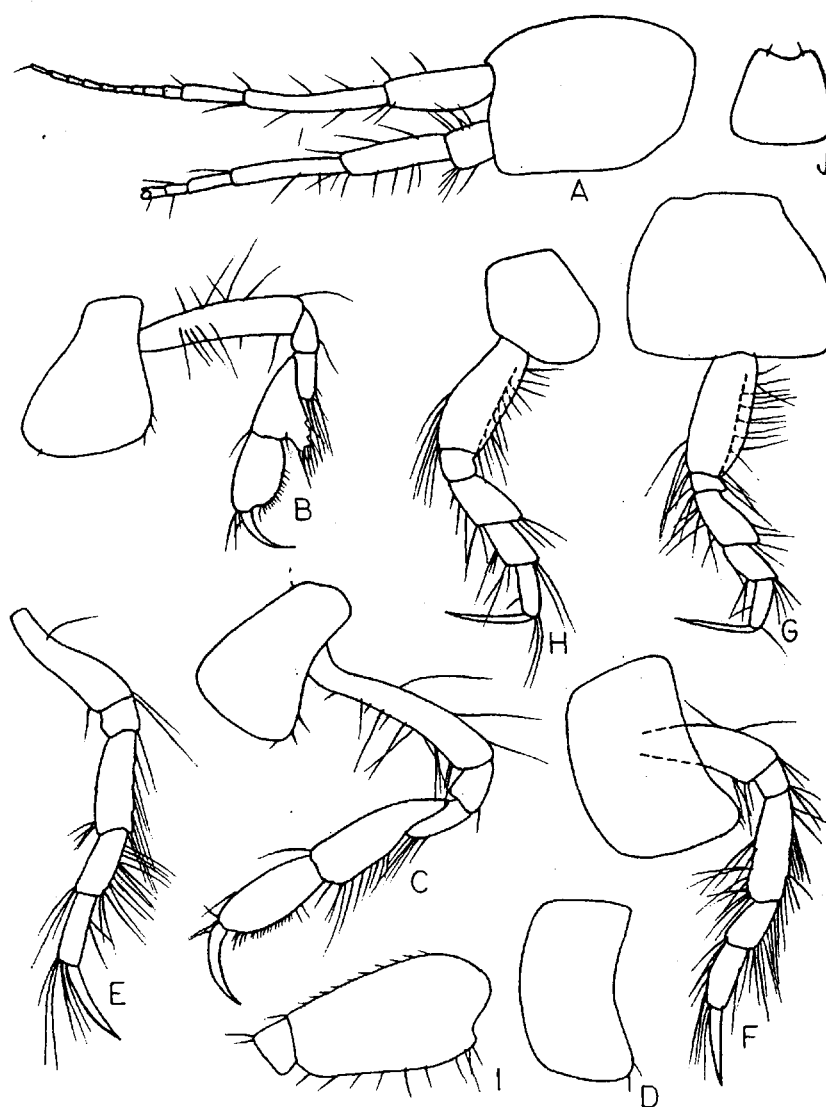


Fig. 1. *Bathymedon pumilus*, n. sp. Male, 2.5 mm, sta. 4753: A, head; B, C, gnathopods 1, 2; D, coxa 3; E, F, G, H, I, peraeopods 1, 2, 3, 4, 5; J, telson.
