
Eohaustorius sawyeri

Diagnostic Characters:

Rostrum moderate to weak Coxa 1-4 enlarging, coxa 4 dominate Gnathopods feeble and simple Pereopod 4 smaller and unlike pereopod 3, reversed in orientation

P5, segment 4 widest distally, 2X length
Pleon plate 3, postero-dorsal process large, strongly overhanging urosome
Uropod 3, inner ramus with 2-3 marginal setae
P4, segment 5, hind lobe normal, width about equal to length
P7, segment 6 with 3-4 posterior marginal spines groups
G2, basis, hind margin setose throughout
P4, segment 5, posterior lobe, distal margin with spine cluster
P6, segment 5 with posterior marginal spine group
P6 segment 4 subtriangular, widest distally, length <2X width; basis as broad as length




FIG. 6. Eohaustorius sawyeri Bosworth, 1973. Female ov (3.2 mm). Off Long Beach, V.I., B.C.
