

Eohaustorius sencillus

Diagnostic Characters:

Rostrum moderate to weak
Coxa 1-4 enlarging, coxa 4 dominate
Gnathopods feeble and simple
Pereopod 4 smaller and unlike pereopod 3, reversed in orientation
Antennae 1 & 2, flagella 3-segmented
P4, segment 5, hind lobe short, length not greater than depth

Abdominal side plate 3, hind process straight or apex slightly upturned

P6, segment 4 tall, length 2X width, with 5-6 groups of facial spines; basis slender, distinctly narrower than length, subovate

Uropod 1, hind margin of inner ramus with 2 single setae

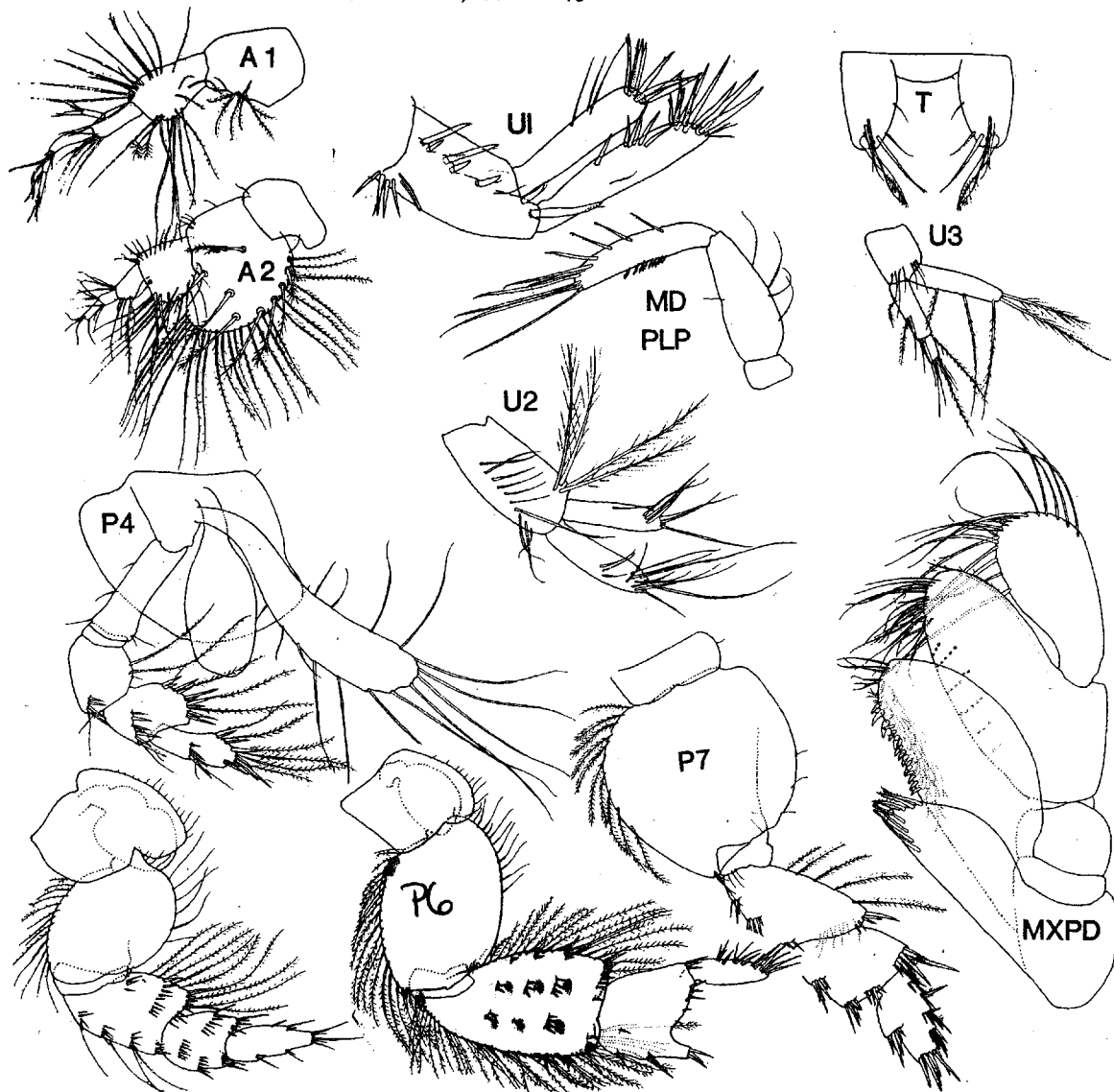


FIG. 7. *Eohaustorius sencillus* Barnard, 1962. Female (3.5 mm). Off Moss Landing, California.
