## Pleusymtes subglaber

## Diagnostic Characters:

- Coxa 1 bent forwards distally, apex often acute
- Antenna 1 peduncular segment 1 without acute distal process
- Coxal gill lacking on peraeopod 7
- Dactyl is straight, pectinate
- Pleon 3 subquadrate, hind corner usually acurninate or produced, hind margin not serrated
- Telson keeled proximally
- Coxa 1-3 smooth posteroventrally
- E3 with large tooth
- Rostrum not significant in size
- Body without carinae




Figure 3.28. Pleusymptes subglaber (from Barnard and Given, 1960).
