

Listriella melanica

Diagnostic Characters:

- Antenna 1, article 2 distinctly shorter than article 1
- P 2-5 typically darkly pigmented
- E1 posterior margin rounded (female) or sub-acute (male)
- Antenna 1, article 2 with pigment distally
- Body pigmentation and eyes present
- Article 5 of gnathopods 1 and 2 weakly produced, thick, blunt, and not produced along posterior margin of article 6
- Outer ramus of uropod 3 bi-articulate

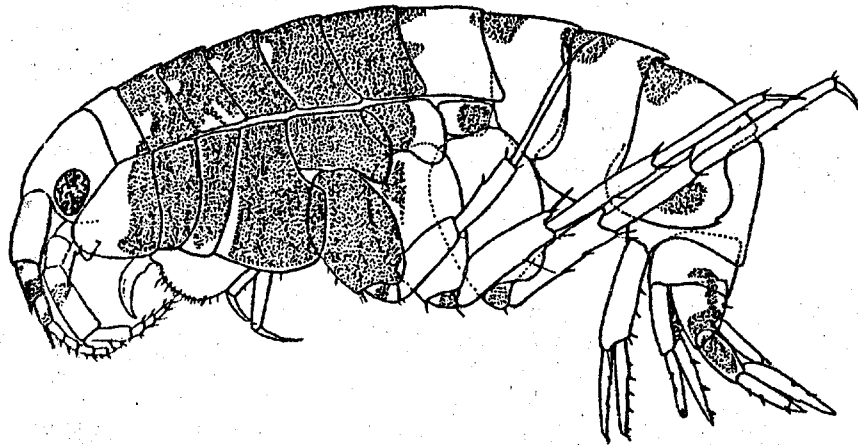


Fig. 1. *Listriella melanica* n. sp. A female specimen 2.75 mm long from sta. 4847.

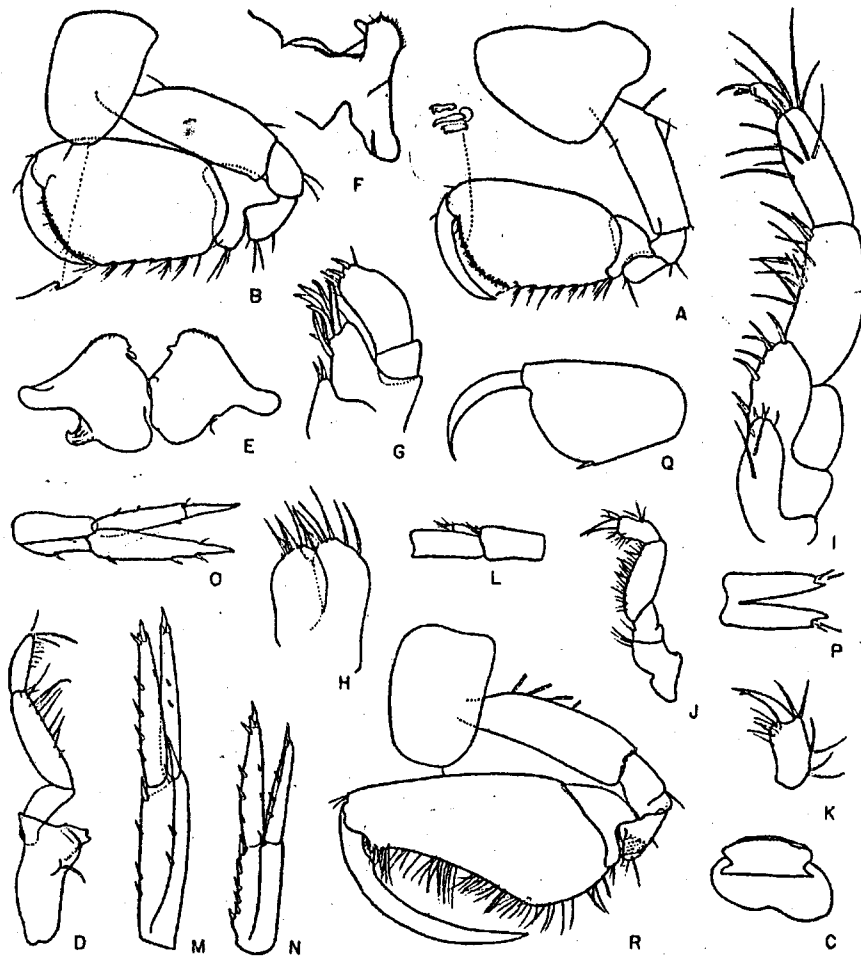


Fig. 2. *Listriella melanica* n. sp. A-P. Female, 3 mm., sta. 4758. A, B, gnathopods 1, 2; C, upper lip; D, mandible; E, F, lower lip; G, H, maxillae 1, 2; I, J, K, maxilliped; L, part of antenna 1 and accessory flagellum; M, N, O, uropods, 1, 2, 3; P, telson. Q-R. Male, 4 mm., sta. 4853, gnathopods 1, 2.
