Syrrhoe longifrons

Diagnostic Characters:

- Eyes huge and united above
- Coxae 4 much shorter and smaller than 3
- Gnathopodal palms transverse
- Article 6 of gnathopods short
- Gnathopod propodus with serrate spines
- Antenna 1, article one and two with distal tooth
- Coxa 1 not distally broadened
- Cephalon extended as a forehead
- Telson cleft nearly 3/4ths of the way




FIGURE 7.—Syrrhoe longifrons, new species, male: a, anterior end of animal; b, distal end of gnathopod 1; c, posterior margin of second joint of percopod 3; d, distal end of telson.
