Distinguishing Characteristics:

Four oblique ridges on each side of the carapace

Short pseudorostrum with a vertical margin below, and a strong
anterolateral tooth.

Anterior margin of fifth somite coarsely serrate

Strong pointed posterolateral teeth on fifth somite

Telson half as long as last somite, rounded, unarmed, little longer
than broad

Brilliant red pigmentation (varies in location individually) in living specimens

Appearing somewhat as tranverse striping
