Distinguishing Characteristics:

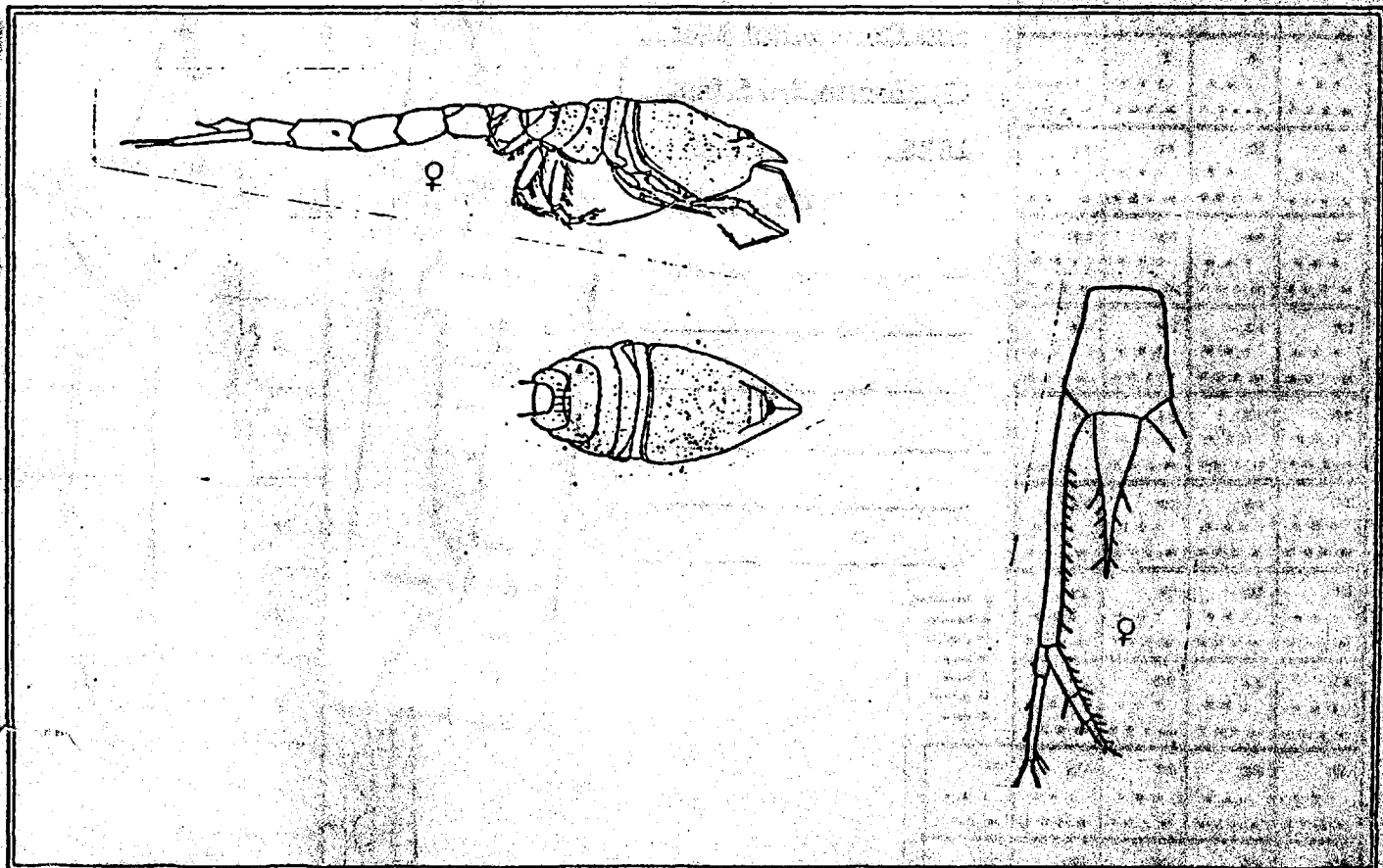
Surface of carapace and free thoracic sternites is rough, covered with fine denticles.

Two oblique impressions extend over the frontal lobe which, from a side view, appear as steps

Three or four lateral spines on telson, but no terminal spines

Long slender antennule in female

Peduncle of uropod about 1/3 longer than telson with about 16 spines on inner margin
