Class Malacostraca, Subclass Eumalacostraca, Order Isopoda, Family Munnopsidae

DIAGNOSTIC CHARACTERS:

Small body size

Head broad, vaulted posteriorly, with flattened frons; frontal arch strongly calcified; semicircular; labrum and clypeus triangular.

Dorsal surfaces of body with scattered fine simple setae

Uropods short, biramous, somewhat inflated

Exopod distinctly longer than protopod

Pereonites 1 – 4 free and loosely articulated

Pleotelson rounded, somewhat inflated
