Class Malacostraca, Subclass Eumalacostraca, Order Tanaidacea, Family Tanaidae

## **DIAGNOSTIC CHARACTERS:**

Cephalothorax narrowed anteriorly.

Head as wide as long w/anterior margin triangulate between the eyes.

Coxa of pereopod 1 with large protuberance.

Carpus of pereopod 2 w/ 4 caudal and 2 rostral spines.

First antennae 3 segments.

Second antennae 5 segments.

Second somite is shortest.

Somites 4 and 5 are the longest.

Abdomen has 6 segments and the last 3 are shorter than the first 3.

**梦** Only 3 pairs of pleopoda.




FIG. 16.—TANAIS NORMANI.




Fig. 17.—Tanais normani. First Gnatropod.  $\times$  44.




Fig. 18.—Tanais normani. a, First antenna.  $\times$  44. b, Second antenna.  $\times$  44.
