






Ostracoda: Myodocopida: Philomedidae: Philomedes sp LA1 Haney 2004

(Prepared by D. Pasko, 15June2018)

Distinguished from *Philomedes dentatus* Poulson 1962 and *Philomedes* sp A Cohen 1975 by: (1) the presence of a distal tooth on the rostrum (vs. flat); (2) 11 caudal furca claws (vs. 10); (3) absence of a long peg surrounded by short pegs on the seventh limb (vs. presence of one long peg in *Philomedes* sp A).
