

KEY TO THE SPECIES OF THE GENUS AMPHIPLUS

- 1 (2) Arm spines, especially central-most, that are on the arm joint have a hyaline crossbar. (Two tentacle scales present).

Amphiplus hexacanthus*

- 2 (1) Arm spines lack a crossbar. (One, possibly two tentacle scales present.)

- 3 (4) Ventral interradia (interbrachial space) lacks scaling.

Amphiplus strongyloplax

- 4 (3) Ventral interradia scaled.

Amphiplus macraspis

* Original type specimens lack disk, thus presence or absence of scaling in ventral interradia is unknown.
