CLASS HOLOTHOROIDEA

Subclass Dendrochirotacea

Order Dendrochirotida

Diagnosis. Tentacles highly branched, 10-30 in number. Calcareous ring simple or complex; retractor muscles present. (e.g., Psolidium, Psolus, Lissothuria.)

Family Psolidae

Diagnosis. Dorsal body wall more or less completely covered by scales. Ventral body wall flat, not covered by scales, functioning as a "sole". Mouth and anus dorsal, usually protected by valves.
