- 1. Thorax with 10 setigers, all capillaries.
- Setiger 1 biramous.
- 3. Epithelium smooth.
- Transition from thorax to abdomen not abrupt.
- 5. Anterior abdominal setigers cylindrical, then somewhat moniliform, becoming collared further back.
- Notopodia of first few abdominal setigers raised ridges that approach mid-dorsally.
- 7. Branchia absent.

## Distribution:

Western Canada to southern California, shelf and canyon depths.




Fig. 1. Anterior end, lateral view:
