Diagnostic characters:

- 1. Thorax with 12 setigers; first setiger with notosetae only.
- 2. Last 2 thoracic setigers with hooks in the neuropodia; all notosetae capillaries.
- 3. Thorax tapers gradually into abdomen.
- 4. Thorax weakly areolate.
- 5. Palmate branchiae present in posterior abdomen; dorsally situated.

## Related species and differences:

Leiochrides <u>hemipodus</u> - thoracic setae all capillaries. i.e., no hooks in thoracic neuropodia.

## Distribution:

Central and southern California, canyon and slope depths (600-1000 m). Specific locales: Santa Maria Basin, Point Conception, Point Dume, Orange County Deep Sludge, Santa Monica Bay, Tanner Canyon.
