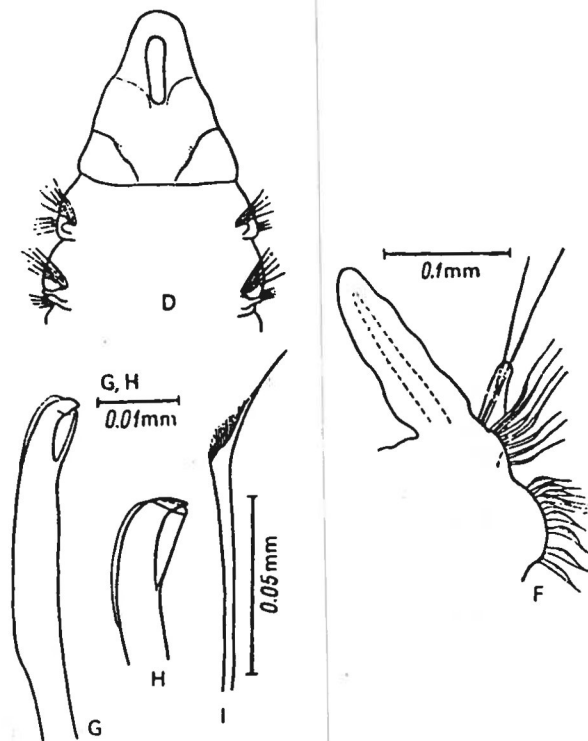

- 1) Median antennae short, does not reach past setiger 1.
- 2) Modified setae falcate with sub-distal hood
- 3) No terminal or sub-terminal arista

Modified setae most like Acmira catherine. The median antennae is much shorter in A. cerrutii. Also A. cerrutii lacks a sub-distal spine on its modified-postbranchial setae.
