

Syllis (Typosyllis) farallonensis vs. *S (T) sp SD2*

CHARACTER	<i>Syllis (Typosyllis) farallonensis</i>	<i>Syllis (Typosyllis) sp SD2</i>
Articles midbody dorsal cirri	~4-5 (not well defined) / base and terminal articles usually longer than others	~10 (can be more) and they are relatively well defined and approximately uniform in size
Secondary tooth on compound setae	Poorly defined throughout the body although visible on some posterior setae / Anterior setae without any indication of secondary tooth (blades relatively broad and rounded terminally)	Poorly defined anteriorly where the 2 nd tooth is very reduced / Compound setae on posterior segments with moderately well formed secondary tooth
Pygidial appendages	Two shorter (w:l = ~1:6) laterals are smooth (not articulated)	Two long laterals with well defined articles (moniliform) and shorter, smooth unpaired median
