

# *Eohaustorius brevicuspis*

## Diagnostic Characters:

Rostrum moderate to weak  
Coxa 1-4 enlarging, coxa 4 dominate  
Gnathopods feeble and simple  
Pereopod 4 smaller and unlike pereopod 3, reversed in orientation

**P7, basis wider than deep, hind cusp rounded**

**Pleon plate 3, process strong**

**P4, segment 5, distal lobe base smooth**

**P6, segment 4 with at least one other spine cluster above lower row**

**P6, segment 5, lacking posterior marginal spines**

**P6, segment 4 subtriangular, widest distally, length <2X width; basis as broad or broader than length**

**Pleon plate 3, hind process nearly straight, if hooked, not recurved**

**P4, segment 5, hind lobe shorter, deeper, length less than 2X depth**

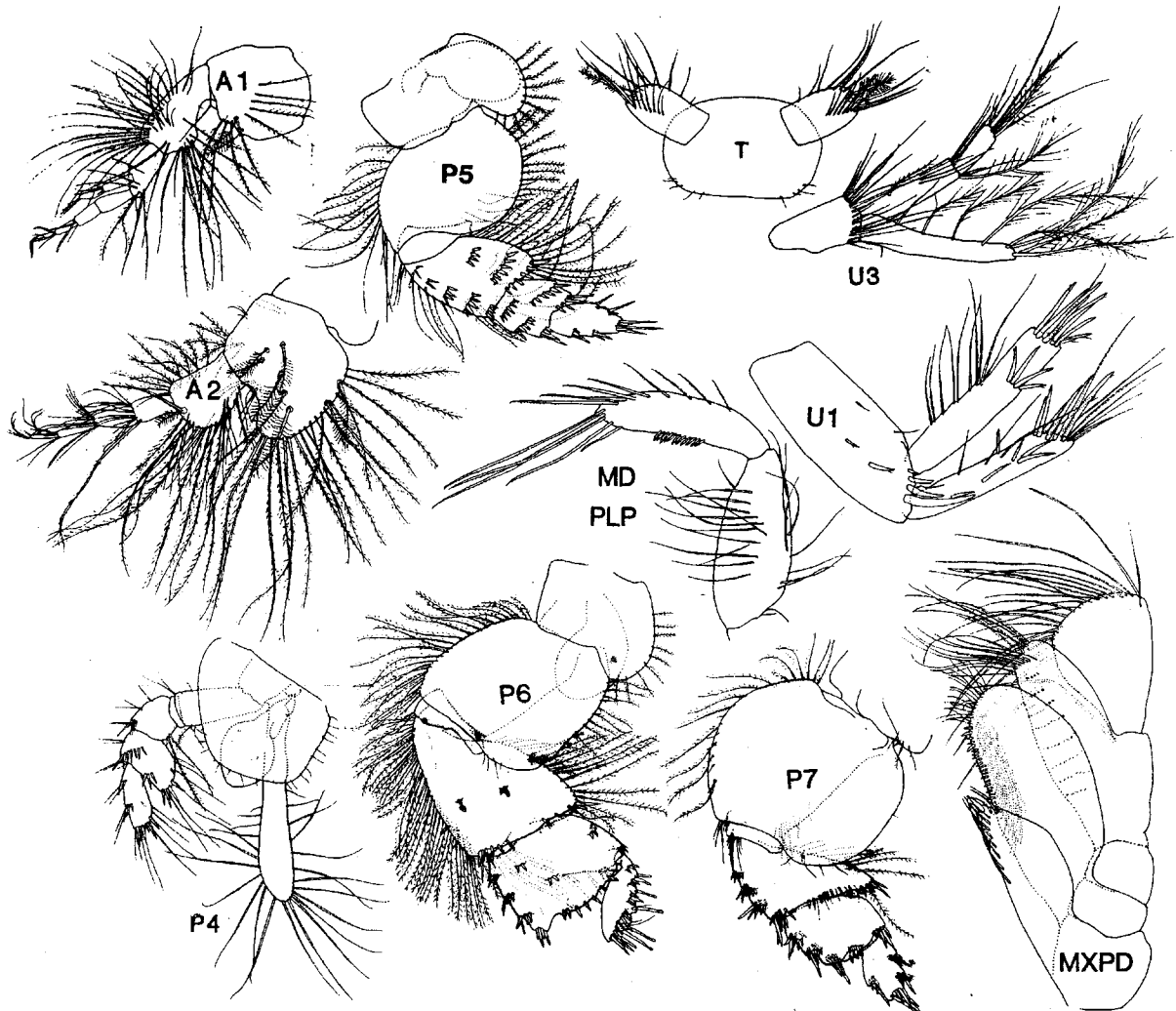


FIG. 10. *Eohaustorius brevicuspis* Bosworth, 1973. Female ov (4.5 mm). Seal Rock, Oregon.
