

Gammaropsis effrenus

Diagnostic Characters:

Coxae 1-5 not deeper than the body plates

Coxa 1 large and subquadrate

G2, male and female, lacks palm; articles 5 & 6 are thin and subequal in length, dactyl short

G1, male, article 5 very short compared with article 6

All peraeopods short

U3 peduncle very short and subequal to U3 rami

Head lobe produced but no tooth

Urosome not dorsally cusped

G1 and G2, male and female, subequal

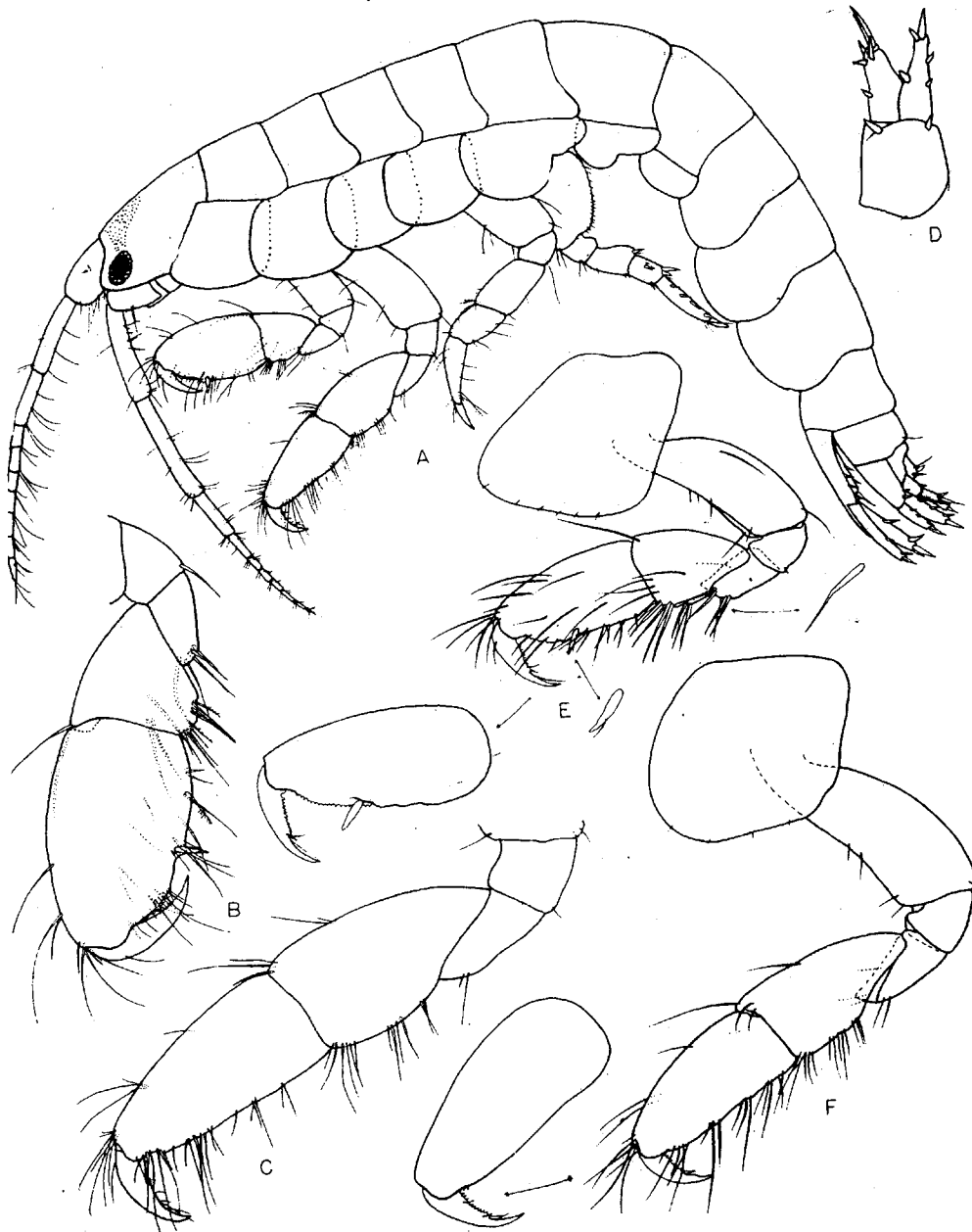

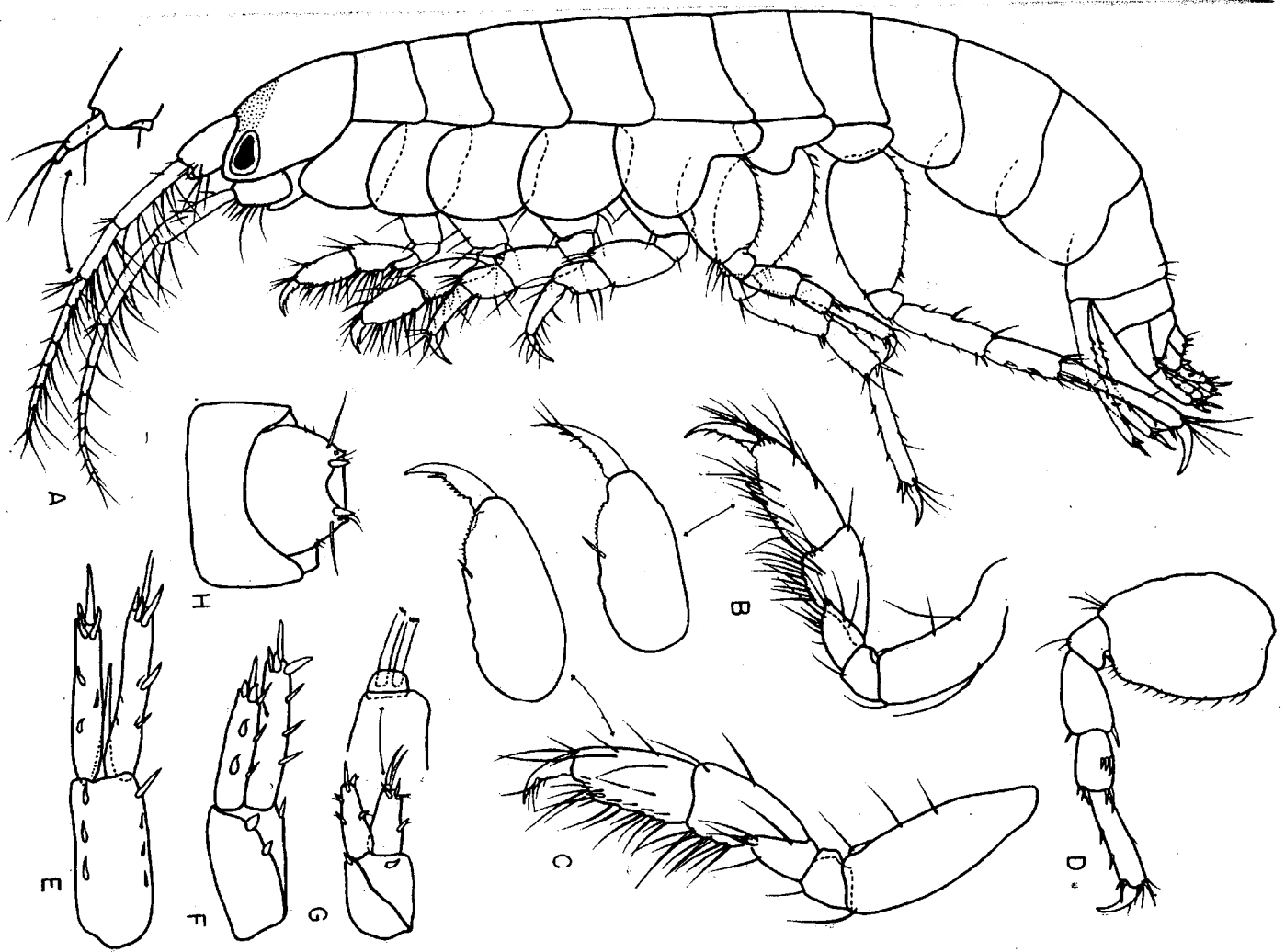
