

Tiburonella viscana

Diagnostic Characters:

Head elongate, produced into cylindric rostrum anterior to eyes, bearing ventral retrorse protrusion.

Article 1 of antenna 1 short, accessory flagellum multiarticulate

Pereopods fossorial, posterior members elongate, P5 relatively large in relation to P 3 & 4

Rostrum has a series of head pits each bearing a stiff setule.

Head with apical rostral process between antennae

Article 2 of antenna 1 not exceeding 1.1 times as long as article 1, coxa 3 distally broad

Pleonite 3 naked

Coxa 1 of ordinary length and rectangular

Telson lacking lateral brush of setae, posterior lobe of coxa 4 tapering.
