Both male and female of  $\underline{C}$ . hartae the same pattern of anastomosing flat ridges elevated above general level of carapace.

Distribution: Puget Sound to Point Loma; 9-300 m.




Figure 1. Carapace (from Lie, 1969)

Figure 2. Telson (from Lie, 1969)


Figure 3. Carapace (from MBC, unpublished)




