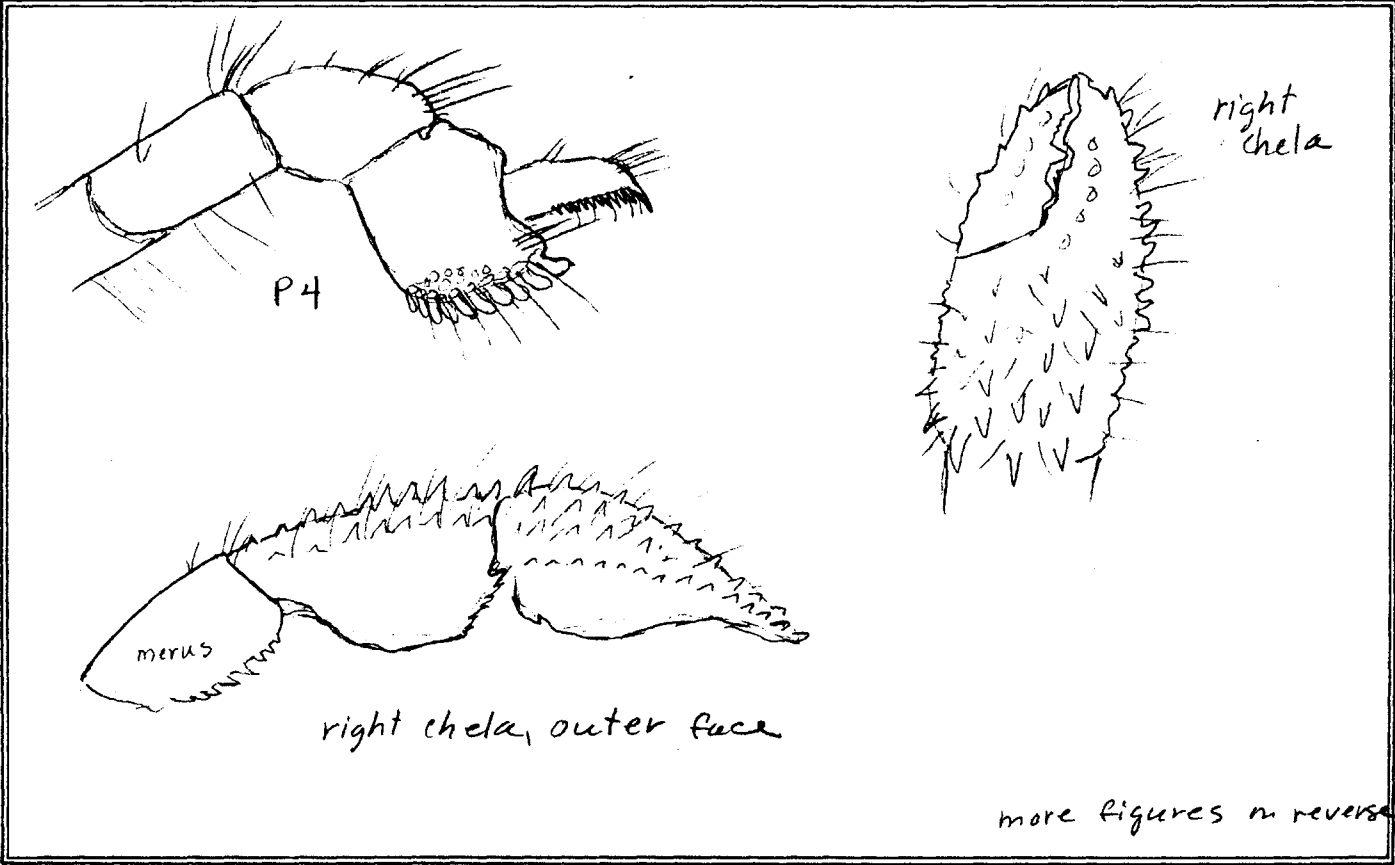
Distinguishing Characteristics:

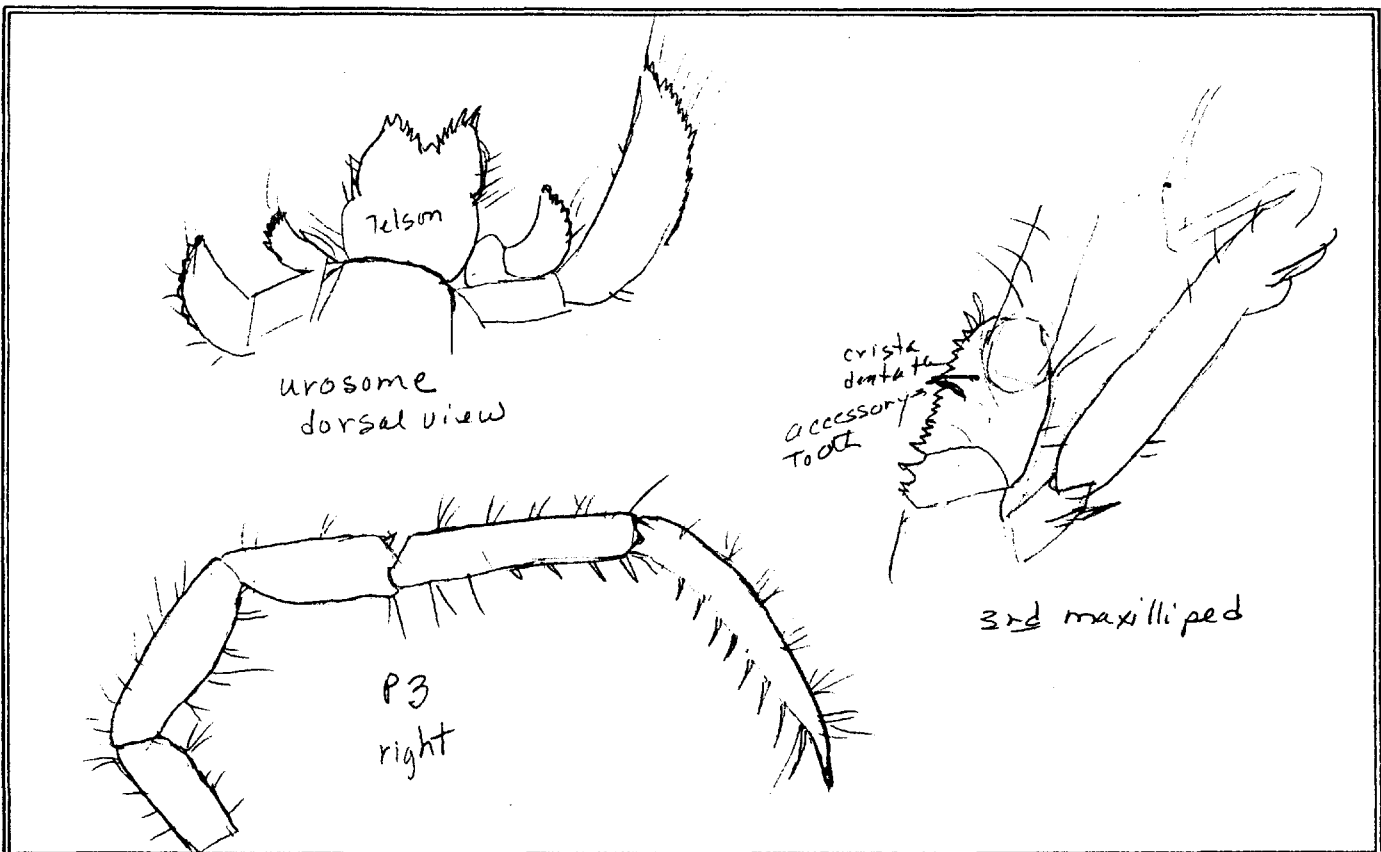
Right chela larger than left. Chelae less slender than in *P. laurentis*  
Walking legs (P2 & 3) slender, dactyl long, dactyl & propodus with large spines on ventral margin.

Pereopod 4 with large spatulate spines on <sup>distal</sup> projection of propodus, dactyl straight except corneous tip, with large spines along distal 2/3 of ventral margin.

Telson with a 90° cleft, with many large recurved spines, increasing in size toward tip; more deeply cleft than *P. makarovi*, spines larger and fewer than *P. laurentis*

Ⓐ more spinous than in *P. makarovi*.
