DIAGNOSTIC CHARACTERISTICS:




Fig. 1 Female Podochela lobifrons

1. Carapace flattened with two medial tubercles and poorly developed cardiac tubercles (Fig. 1).

- 2. Postorbital spine small, sometimes more readily visible from the ventral side.
- 3. Distinct hepatic spine, broadly strap-shaped.
- 4. First abdominal segment with two median tubercles.




Fig. 2 Right first male pleopod (from Garth 1958)

 - 5. Male first right pleopod as illustrated (Fig. 2).

RELATED SPECIES AND CHARACTER DIFFERENCES:

1. <u>Podochela hemphilli</u> does not have a strap-shaped hepatic spine and has one tubercle on the first abdominal segment.

DISTRIBUTION: Gulf of California to Pt. Mugu, California
