
- 1. Carapace smooth, dorsal anterior margin depressed.
- 2. Abdominal segments smooth.
- 3. Telson with two pair of moveable spines on dorsal surface.
- 4. Telson with two pair of spines at posterolateral corners, outer spines small.
- 5. Antennal scale unproduced.
- 6. Tip of fixed finger truncated.
- 7. Moveable spine on ischium of 3rd and 4th walking legs.


Related species and character differences:

<u>B. harrimani</u> is closely related but lacks a spine on the ischium of the walking legs; fixed finger of cheliped is not truncated and the antennal scale is produced anteriorly.
