## Distinguishing Characteristics:

Body elongate, 9 times as long as wide, 9 mm: .5 mm. Cephalon anterolateral angles  
very slightly exceeding rostral forward extent. Eyes large, consisting of about 13  
ocelli. Endopod of uropod extending beyond telson. Exopod shorter than telson and  
with a slightly sinuate posterolateral border. Posterolateral pleotelson borders  
finely dentate. Telson elongate, with an evenly convex setiferous posterior margin  
and finely serrate posterolateral borders.
