Class Malacostraca, Subclass Eumalacostraca, Order Tanaidacea, Family Tanaidae

DIAGNOSTIC CHARACTERS:

Cephalothorax narrowed anteriorly.

Head as wide as long w/ anterior margin triangulate between the eyes.

Coxa of pereopod 1 with large protuberance.

Carpus of pereopod 2 w/ 4 caudal and 2 rostral spines.

First antennae 3 segments.

Second antennae 5 segments.

~~Second~~ ^{First} somite is shortest.

Somites 4 and 5 are the longest.

Abdomen has 6 segments and the last 3 are shorter than the first 3.

★ Only 3 pairs of pleopoda.

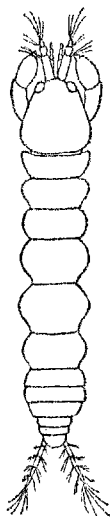


FIG. 16.—TANAIS NORMANI. × 114.

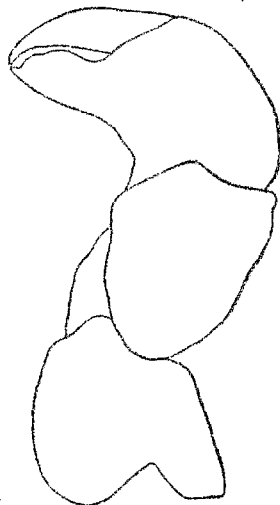


FIG. 17.—TANAIS NORMANI. FIRST GNATHOPOD. × 44.

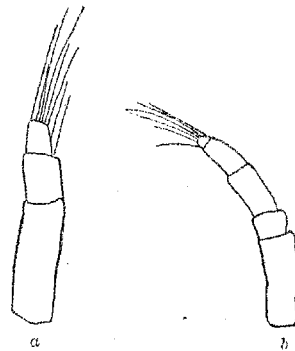


FIG. 18.—TANAIS NORMANI. a, FIRST ANTENNA. × 44. b, SECOND ANTENNA. × 44.
