- Keys Used: Clark, H.L. 1907. The apodus holothurians. A monograph of the Synaptidae and Molpadiidae. Smithsonian Contributions to Knowledge 35: 1-231.
- Important Characters: Spicules from the tip of the tail are small tables
 with a tall spire. Sometimes the sides of the top of the tables
 are drawn out into a handle. The figures in H.L. Clark are very
 misleading and are supposedly from small specimens; I am basing
 my identification on spicules from syntypes.
- Related Species and Character Differences: Molpadia musculus. This species has long fusiform rods in the tail.
