## Diagnostic characters:

- 1. Shell very elongate, thin, compressed, length to 30 mm.
- 2. Smooth, with only incremental growth striae.
- 3. Rostrum narrow, blunt.
- 4. Periostracum highly varnished, iridescent.
- 5. Escutcheon narrow, poorly defined.

## Related species / character differences:

Nuculana conceptionis can be confused with the deep water (2,000-2,500 m) species, N. extenuata, but the latter has fine concentric lirae, and a longer, narrower rostrum.

Depth range: 300 - 2,300 meters (shallower records??).

Distribution: Pribiloff Islands, Bering Sea to Santa Barbara, California.
